Terms and Conditions



Our beautiful paintable ceramic butterfly is the perfect opportunity for individuals, schools, care homes and other groups and organisations to get involved in a fun, imaginative and engaging way!

We're inviting those who paint their own butterfly to enter our competition by posting a photo of their finished butterfly on Facebook or Twitter, using the hashtag #MyTBFButterfly.

Terms and Conditions

- This Competition is being run by The Benjamin Foundation.
- All entries must be made within the specified competition dates.
- The Competition is open from 1st March 2019 – 30th September 2019, with a deadline for final entries being midnight on 30th September 2019. Any entries received after this date will not be accepted.
- All entries must be made via The Benjamin Foundations Facebook and/or Twitter pages using the #MyTBFButterfly.
- All entries made must be for yourself or on behalf of someone with their consent.
- Any entries for children under the age of 13 must be made by a parent / guardian.
- Multiple entries for an individual butterfly is not permitted. Multiple entries are allowed from a single user for multiple butterflies.
- By entering the competition you agree that your photos can be used for promotion by The Benjamin Foundation in support of Flight for Youth or any other marketing activities related to the butterflies in the future.
- Judging will take place by a panel impartially and all butterflies will be submitted anonymously to the panel. The judges will assess creativity and an agreement must be reached for all shortlisted entries. The judge's decision is final.
- Shortlisted designs will be decided on 1st October and those individuals or groups will be notified by the means through which they submitted their entry. We regret that we cannot individually notify every entrant of the result. If you have not heard from The Benjamin Foundation by 2nd October, we regret that your design has not been selected but we thank you for taking the time to enter.
- All 25 shortlisted butterflies will receive the prize of having their entry mounted and framed, unless specifically requested not to.

- If shortlisted, you agree to loan your entry back to The Benjamin Foundation for the prize of mounting and framing and for the purposes of a public vote at The Benjamin Foundation Family Fun Day on Sunday 27th October. You will be responsible for the dropping off and collection of your butterfly to our Head Office or one of our restore shops.
- All decorated butterflies for public display will be assigned a reference number and this will be written in permanent marker on the back of the butterfly (this will happen when the decorated butterfly is returned to us, to ensure your data is kept safe in line with data protection)
- By loaning us back your butterfly you consent to this being photographed and used in promotion of #FlightForYouth
- Whilst every attention will be given to care for the shortlisted butterflies, The Benjamin Foundation takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to the butterflies during the exhibition.
- The public vote will take place on Sunday 27th October – all entries will be publicly displayed and visitors on the day will be given a 1 – 25 judging sheet, on which they will be asked to submit their vote for the best design. The votes will be counted after the Family Fun Day and the winner will be announced on Monday 28th October.
- The winner will agree to inclusion in a press release and photography to raise awareness of The Benjamin Foundation around the competition.
- The prize is for a £100 Gift Voucher and no cash alternative is given.
- Any entries that fail to comply with competition Terms and Conditions will be disqualified.

The information you provide will be used for will be used for this competition only and will not be shared with any other party.
