WHY FUNDRAISING IS IMPORTANT





With all sources of funding under pressure, any fundraising we receive can make a real difference and allow us to continue to support local people.

Despite being a well-established charity and helping in the region of 2,000 people each year we only have a small number of regular fundraisers and supporters. We are, of course, keen to grow this number and will always look for ways that provide support and recognition in return.

HOW FUNDRAISING MONEY HELPS





We want to end youth homelessness and we're tackling the problem locally by providing a home and support to over 100 vulnerable young people at any time.

£25 could buy a new duvet, pillows and covers for a young person when they arrive at one of our accommodation centres with few possessions of their own.

We deliver a range of services to help children and young people to talk about their feelings in order to build self-confidence, resilience and helping them to recognise their 'inner-wealth'.

£180 pays for 6 sessions of emotional wellbeing support for a young person. We delivered 12,446 sessions of emotional wellbeing support to young people in local schools in the 2017/18 academic year.





We provide positive activities for young people with limited opportunities in life. Perhaps they're caring for a relative or they come from a socially deprived area.

£500 will pay for a residential trip for a group of young people to give them the chance to escape their day-to-day pressures and be a child again.




USE OF VIRGIN MONEY GIVING
