- To help assist and provide care and support in the day to day running of the nursery
- To provide a high-quality service for children aged between the ages of 0 and 5 year's old
- To provide a full range of activities and support for the children who attend the nursery

Main duties

Service Delivery

- Work closely with parents/guardians, community leaders and staff from other agencies to identify the needs of young people, strategies to meet those needs and their implementation
- Ensure the 'special needs' of each child/young person are fully taken into account in relation to any activity within the group
- Assist in ensuring that the children/young people attending the group have access to a full
 and varied programme of educational and social-education activities and that these activities
 within reason fully reflect their needs and wishes and that they comply with EYFS and Ofsted
 requirements
- Ensure the safety and well-being of the children/young people at all times
- Ensure awareness of all emergency and safety procedures relating to individual and/or group need
- Assist in maintaining administration, registers, membership forms etc. as required for both Health & Safety purposes and the smooth running of the group including appropriate risk assessments. To ensure regular observations and learning stories are kept up to date
- Be aware of the developments within this type of work both locally and nationally and use these to the full benefit of the children/young people involved in the project
